### **CURRENT CONSULTANT FEE SCHEDULE - EFFECTIVE 02/08/2024**

A one-day minimum fee of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400) will be required prior to any examination(s) being performed.

**Examination Fee:** Two thousand, four hundred dollars (\$2,400) per day of analytical time (eight-hour day, with a one day minimum). Partial days, in excess of, the first day will be billed at a rate of three hundred dollars (\$300) per hour.

**Rush Cases:** Three thousand, two hundred dollars (\$3,200) per day of analytical time (eight-hour day, with a one day minimum). Partial days, in excess of, the first day will be billed at a rate of four hundred dollars (\$400) per hour.

**Travel Time:** Out-of-state travel time for examination purposes will be billed at a rate of two thousand, four hundred dollars (\$2,400) per day of travel. In state travel will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis.

**Expenses:** All actual expenses associated with either examination or travel will be reimbursed upon presentation of invoice. Travel expenses are based on posted GSA rate travel allowances. All other expenses related to analysis, such as shipping, mail fees, long distance calls, etc. will be based on actual expenses with itemized records available upon request.

**Expert Witness Testimony Fee:** Two thousand, four hundred dollars (\$2,400) per day in court, plus travel expenses. Days spent on site waiting to testify are billed at the same daily rate. Travel days to and from court will be billed at the rate of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400) per day.

**Deposition Fee:** Three hundred (\$300) per hour for all telephone/video depositions, with a one hour minimum (no travel required). Depositions which require travel from the consultants' place of business will be billed at a rate of two thousand four hundred dollars per day (\$2,400) with a one day, eight-hour minimum, plus travel expenses. Subsequent days will be billed at a rate of two thousand, four hundred dollars (\$2,400) per day.
